1. Entering clear text passwords doesn't work because MySQL encrypts passwords.

## This example is WRONG

```
INSERT INTO user VALUES ("graham", "password");
```

The MySQL website recommends the use of the password() function, which in this context will insert an encrypted value:

```
INSERT INTO user VALUES ("graham", PASSWORD("password"));
```

## Unfortunately, this **DOES NOT WORK EITHER!**

Consider the following:

```
root@ddi02.dd-industries.com: /var/named

mysql>
mysq
```

What you **must** remember to do is **restart** MySQL when you change a password!
